

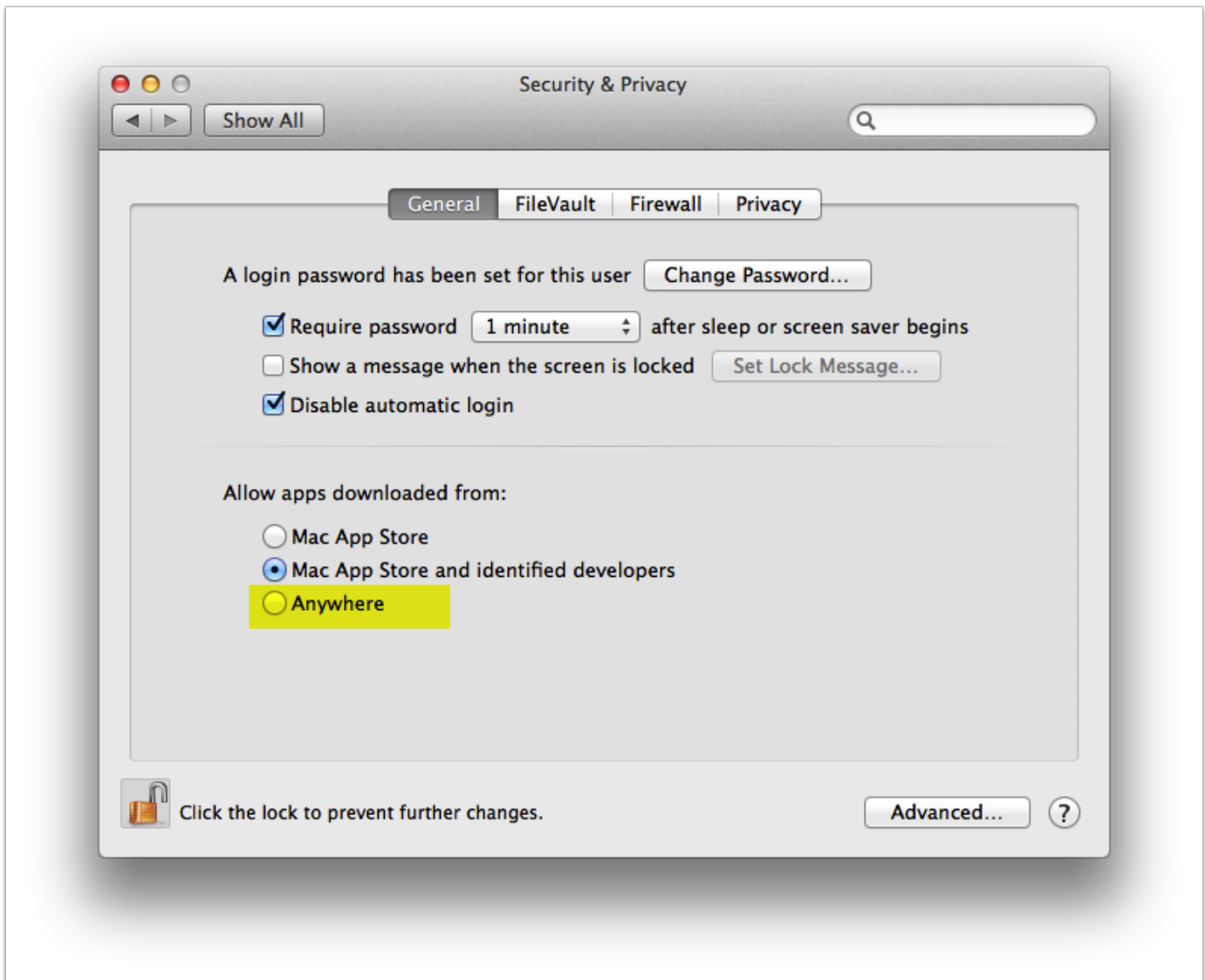
I. System Preferences

Bring up your System Preferences click on **Security & Privacy**



2. Change "Allow apps downloaded from:" to Anywhere

By default the "Allow apps downloaded from:" setting is set to "Mac App Store and identified developers". For older apps and installers you need to change this to "Anywhere" due to security changes in the newer versions of Mac OS X.



3. Allow From Anywhere

Once you change the setting, you can now run the problematic app or installer and it should work as expected.

When finished you may want to change the "Allow apps downloaded from:" setting back to its default setting for security purposes.
